**RESOLUTION OF THE NYACK VILLAGE BOARD  
TO APPOINT A COMMUNITY SUSTAINABILITY TASK FORCE**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Nyack through Resolution No. 2013-48 pledged to participate in the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation’s “Climate Smart Communities” initiative in order to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and adapt to a changing climate, and

**WHEREAS**, the Village is pursuing Climate Smart Communities certification, and

**WHEREAS**, to become a Certified Climate Smart Community, one of the actions the Village must take is to appoint a Community Task Force consisting of local officials, residents, local government staff members, and other stakeholders to support the planning and implementation of climate action strategies, and

**WHEREAS**, the Task Force will act as an advisory board or steering committee, to advise the local government broad range of environmental issues through plans, education and statutes, aligned with the Climate Smart Communities Program,

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Village of Nyack hereby establishes a Community Sustainability Task Force for the New York State Climate Smart Communities Program, with membership to be appointed by the Village Board.
