

Meeting October 25, 2023

Meeting started at 7:00pm

**Marina:** Marina parking lot paving has been done, wondering if there will be striping that indicates the trailer run-up area to the ramp. We had an accident last week with a trailer injuring someone, one reason was the amount of vehicular traffic in the area where he was backing up. Village said they'll follow up with the contractor.

Also noticed that the parking stripes aren't situated so they angle toward the river, but straight in toward the inlet, which is what was proposed. The Village said that was the engineer's design.

There have been some discussions about moving the trailer parking farther back toward the western wall to free up more prime parking along the inlet for cars, and to prevent trailers from sticking out so much in a higher-trafficked area. The Village said it was considered, but there wasn't enough room for trailers farther back toward the retailing wall.

**Memorial Park:** Great lawn project is underway, Village is working with Marcy Denker on some revisions/suggestions regarding plantings. She also Marcy also recommended a stone dust path instead of asphalt in front of the Memorial Steps. It appears that we will award all four contracts to Paladino Concrete Creations. We are just waiting on Rockland County ARPA approval.

**Children's Playground:** New swings have been installed, wondering about the status of the toddler area and solid-surface walkways. Village said the bids are being reviewed and waiting to see if contractor can secure his SAM.gov registration before the next board meeting

Asked the Village about the grant for the riverfront walkway area, or the grant to rebuild the bulkhead near the River Club property, but they haven't yet had a response.
