

Nyack Parks Meeting: 07/26/22

Meeting started at 6:30 via ZOOM call

Points of Discussion:

1 – Jim is following up with Andy on the following grants:

- Resurface the Marina Parking Lot
- Seed/fertilize/maintain the great lawn
- Resurface the children's playground and pathway

2 — New playground equipment to replace deteriorating wooden houses, and possibly some smaller play pieces for toddlers and younger children. Pending continued discussion of equipment choices, whether sandbox should be removed or replaced.

3— Parking Lot – questions for Andy:

- a - What is the job responsibilities for the Parking Attendant, so we can understand the difference between Parking Attendant and Parking Authority
- b - Noted that the marina parking lot stripes were all redone, all in white. When will more handicap parking spots be added by the entrance to Memorial Bridge?

4 – Checking on the tree planted on the upper level, by the staircase – seems to be in the middle of the grass...is this the correct spot for it?

5 – Kayakers have been inquiring about winter storage. Can they do so? Is there a fee? How would these be stored/covered? Jim will request an updated renters list and email them about interest.

Still pending:

a- Piling stuck in the marina has been marked. Jim asking company when it will be removed.

b - Possible tree donation in Memorial Park. *** no final determination*

Mara D'Auria approached the village and Parks Commission about donating a tree or bench as a memorial to former Nyack resident Josh Friedrich. Continued discussion about which option would be the most appropriate; if a bench, it's possible that there could also be a tree as part of the tree program. Als will consider best location.

c- Possible chess table/benches. *** no final determination*

Question of Who and Where purchasing the bench?

The village received a call about the possible donation of a heavy-duty chess table and bench. Parks Commission discussed possible locations with Marcy, there appears to be a good location along the brook area. Jim will be meeting with Village Administrator to review possible alternate locations in Veteran's Park on Main Street.
