

Nyack Parks Meeting: 10/26/22

Meeting started at 7pm via ZOOM call

**Points of Discussion:**

1 – When will the resurfacing of the children’s playground and pathway begin? Village working with playground consultant to help determine needs.

2 — New playground equipment. Questions about status of playground equipment purchases, and the budget for fixing or replacing current equipment.

3 – Audit of benches in the park – need to count and locate them on a map and which need repair. Jim said he will undertake this project.

4 – Addition of a Horseshoe Pit and Bocci Ball Court. Discussions about whether a horseshoe pit will be implemented in Memorial Park. The park used to have one, and one is actually included in the master plan for the park.

5 – Marina Parking Lot: (Andrea to follow up with Andy). Asking the village to reassess parking spaces, spots reserved for trailer parking, etc. Nothing will be done until the village ascertains if it will receive a grant to redo the parking in the marina and address flooding issues. Does the village still have a parking consultant?

Another issue: The amount of vehicle traffic has significantly increased in the surrounding streets and within the lot, should discuss with village administrator to analyze traffic flow and consider any other safety measures for pedestrians (adding raised cross walks) and vehicles to ensure a safe flow of traffic.

There was a suggestion that curb loud noise, tailgating, partying, etc., the village consider allowing paid overnight resident parking in the lot. Andrea to follow up with Andy/Joe.
