

The Village goal is to increase public participation by informing the public of the numerous venues available for their participation. The Village will continue their affiliation with the Stormwater Consortium and Cornell Cooperative. Participation in clean up events with Keep Rockland Beautiful remain well attended. The Green Infrastructure/ Sustainability Committee, Tree Committee and Parks Commission remain active. HS students participated in the PLUS program.

The Village continues to observe a high level of participation in annual clean up events. Approx. 110 people participated in clean up efforts at numerous locations. Approx. 94 bags of trash, 21 bags of recyclables, 3 tires were collected. The Sustainability Committee, Riverkeeper, Earth Day events, Climate Smart, Farmers Market venue all continue to be active forums providing participation opportunity and information. The Erosion Control class and Fertilizer class was well attended.

The goal of the Village is to continue the intensive program of cleaning and maintaining the catch basins especially in the downtown areas where garbage is the primary pollutant of concern. The street sweeping program will continue on a regular, 7 day schedule in the downtown district, focusing on the commercial areas. The building inspector and code enforcement officer will continue to be vigilant in the detection of potential illicit discharges.

**B. Briefly summarize the observations that indicated the overall effectiveness of this Measurable Goal.**

The increased maintenance schedule has eliminated many incidences of flooding during moderate storm events. Orangetown Sewer continues to investigate I & I under the DEC Consent Order directive to eliminate sewer overflows. A cross connection at 142 Main St was identified and eliminated. An illicit discharge due to a broken pipe at Nyack Hosp was addressed. Two illicit discharges at Pavion discovered and eliminated. All outfalls have been inspected.
